This half term our learning challenge question will be "Where do we live?"

During this topic, the children will be learning about England and where they live, what Stoke on Trent is famous for and where our new schools will be. During the half term, we will be visiting the local park and our local area.

In R.E. the children will be learning about who is special to them and why.

Literacy

In Phonics, the children will continue to learn the letters of the alphabet and their sounds.

The children are continuing to listen to the sounds in words and are learning to push the sounds together to make words.

The children are beginning to practise writing the letters of the alphabet and also their names. Please help your child write the letters of the alphabet and their names at home! If your child can already write their first name then please start to practise writing their surname



Maths

In maths, the children are working on their numbers to 6 and are beginning to match quantities and recognise quantities without counting. This is called subitising.

The children will also begin to recognise and talk about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.



Reading

All children have a reading book. Please read with your child at home and encourage them to talk in sentences about their story.

Some children now have reading books with words. Please support your child to say the letter sounds and push the sounds together to read the word.

Children must bring in their reading books every day.

Please read every night with your child at home and sign their diary.

We shall continue with our library sessions every Friday.

Now that the weather is getting warmer, please send your child to school with a sun hat, water bottle and apply sun cream before coming to school.
