	Observe changes across the four seasons Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies	 There are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter. Certain events/weather patterns happen in different seasons. Different types of weather include sunshine, rain, hail, wind, snow, fog, lightning, storm and cloud. The UK has typical weather in each of the seasons. For example, winter is cold and sometimes frosty, whereas summer is warm and sometimes sunny. Day length (the number of daylight hours) is longer in the summer months and shorter in the winter months.
