Each half term, we explore new topics and set a main focus question to guide the children's learning and curiosity. This week, our learning will centre around **Bonfire Night** and what happens during this celebration. The children will have lots of fun creating their own firework pictures using PVA glue, creative mark-making tools, and glitter.

The focus question for this half term is: **"What is your favourite nursery rhyme?"** Each week, the children will learn a new nursery rhyme, sing it together, and share their favourite parts.

Literacy

In maths, we will be beginning to

- Recognise and name 2D shapes
- Recognise the number 1 and number 2
- Discuss and understand the meaning of 1 and 2
- Recognise and create a repeated pattern
