Year 5 Newsletter Summer 1

For this half term, Year 5 will be focusing on **geography** and trying to answer the question, **Natural Resources: what are they, where are they found, why are they important?** Throughout the term, we will be looking at where natural resources are found, what we use them for, whether they are renewable or not and what impact they have on our planet.

English

This term, Year 5 will be using book, **The**Matchbox Diary as an inspiration for our
writing. We will be concentrating on
flashback stories, using our skills to
create exciting narratives, which look back
at special memories and events.



<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be concentrating on geometry (angles and measurement) before moving onto position and movement, looking at rotation and translation as well as plotting grid references and drawing a variety of shapes.

Reading

All children are expected to read at least 4 times a week at home. If they do this, they will receive a raffle ticket and will be entered into a draw for a brandnew book. Children, who read 5 times a week, will also receive 5 minutes of extra playtime on Friday.

Reading diaries should be signed by an adult and a note of which pages have been read.

Science

Our science topic for this half term is "How do the Earth, moon and planets move through space to shape our universe?"

During the term we will study how our Earth moves and what impact this has for us as humans. We will also consider the movement of the moon and our place in the wider universe.

<u>P.E.</u>

PE this term will be **swimming** and will take place on a **Wednesday morning**. Children need to bring a towel, a swimming cap, swimming trunks for boys (not Bermuda shorts) and swimming costumes for girls. Children should also bring a snack to have beforehand.
