
# Year 5 Newsletter Summer 2

For this half term, Year 5 will be focusing on history, 'What was life like in Medieval England?' Throughout the unit we will look at the Battle of Bosworth, the Tudor reign, the role of knights in defending England, how the lives of wealthy people were different to poor people and the role of the monarchy.

#### **English**

This term, Year 5 will be using the book,

Robin Hood as inspiration. We will be
writing persuasive letters and nonchronological reports.



#### Reading

All children are expected to read at least 4 times a week at home. If they do this, they will receive a raffle ticket and will be entered into a draw for a brand-new book. Children, who read 5 times a week, will also receive extra playtime.

Reading diaries should be signed by an adult and a note of which pages have been read.

### <u>Maths</u>

This term we will be concentrating on measures. We will be learning how to convert a variety of units including mm, cm, km and kg as well as developing our knowledge of perimeter and volume.

#### <u>Science</u>

Our science topic for this half term is 'How different will you be when you are as old as your grandparents?'
This unit looks at how we change as we move from childhood to adulthood.

## <u>P.E.</u>

PE this term will continue with **swimming** and will take place on a **Wednesday morning**. Children need to bring a towel, a swimming cap, swimming trunks for boys (not Bermuda shorts) and swimming costumes for girls. Children should also bring a snack to have beforehand.
