#### 'Continents and oceans: what can we find out about the world?'

This half term the children will be learning about the continents and oceans around the world. We will look at where the UK is located and compare to other places. When learning about the different continents, we will research famous landmarks, mountains and rivers too.

#### <u>English</u>

Please make sure that your child completes their basic skills spelling homework each week - this will really make a difference when completing writing tasks in school.

We will use our geography knowledge to write fact files about the different continents of the world. I bet the children will be great at finding facts for each continent!

This half term we will become poets! In lessons we will explore the poem 'Mrs Sprocket has a strange machine' before innovating our own version.

#### <u>Maths</u>

Over the next half term, the children will be naming, classifying and describing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. Which ones can you spot in your homes?

Our next topic will be looking at fractions of a shape and an amount. The children will find this much easier if they a secure knowledge of division facts so please encourage your child to access TTRS at home. If you need your login, please speak to the class teacher.

#### Reading
