# Year 4 Newsletter Summer 1




Our geography topic this half term is all about volcanoes and mountains.

#### **English**

## <u>Maths</u>

For this half term, the children will be focusing on money, mass, volume, length, area and perimeter. They will be using their prior knowledge of decimals to help them with these topics.

All children have access to Times Table Rock Stars online. Please encourage your child to access this at home as it will help with their multiplication skills.



#### Reading

Please continue to listen to your children read every night at home. We recognise at times that this is not an easy task, but we thank you for your commitment to this.

The children will have daily guided reading sessions as well as individual readers with the class teacher or support staff.



## <u>Science</u>

This half term, our topic is 'Animals, including humans'. Specifically, we will be looking at the digestive system and the human body. The children will learn all about the function of the digestive system, the names of organs and the function of each one. Additionally, we will be exploring food chains.

### P.E.
