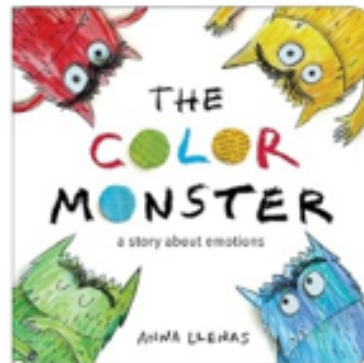


This half term, our learning will be all about colours! The children will be exploring the colours red, blue, yellow, and green through fun stories, activities, and play. We'll be helping the children to notice that colours are everywhere—in books, clothes, nature, and the world around us. We'll also be introducing the Zones of Regulation, where the children begin to link colours with their feelings. This helps the children to find simple ways to talk about how they're feeling throughout the day. Later in the term, we'll head outdoors to look at the beautiful autumn colours and the changes with the seasons.



LITERACY

This half term, the children will be enjoying songs and stories with rhyme and rhythm. We will be focusing on the story *The Colour Monster*, which will help the children to explore feelings through colours. The children will be practising sitting together on the carpet and listening to stories. They will start to join in with familiar, repeated words and phrases.



READING

This half term we will be starting our weekly library sessions.

During these sessions, the children will have the opportunity to choose a library book from the Nursery to take home.

It is really important that parents share these stories with the children at home and sign the reading diaries.

Please read every night with your child at home.

MATHS



This half term, the children will be exploring colours and colour mixing through hands-on activities. They will practise matching and sorting objects by colour as well as sorting and comparing objects by size. Children will also work on completing inset puzzles and using gestures and language such as bigger, little and small to describe and compare sizes.
