MESSAGE FROM MRS SADLER

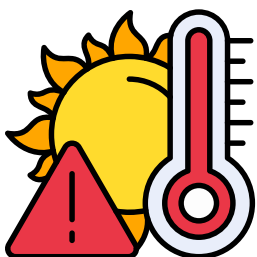
Dear Parents,
